Shades of Grace – Drop by between 9AM – 3PM weekdays to help or visit with the people Shades of Grace serves. Safe House - Items needed are clothing for adult women, infants and children to age 10, socks and underwear; personal care items; bedding for

single beds and cribs; paper products, etc.
