FIRST BROAD STREET UNITED METHODIST WOMEN BY-LAWS

Introduction: United Methodist Women (UMW) is a group of women in each congregation organized for mission. FBSUMW is an integral part of the Kingsport District, the Holston Conference, and the Women's Division of the General Board of Global Ministries of the United Methodist Church

Purpose: An organized unit of the United Methodist Women shall be a community of women whose purpose is to know God and to experience freedom as whole persons through Jesus Christ; to develop a creative, supportive fellowship; and to expand concepts of mission through participation in the global ministries of the church.

FBSUMW STANDING RULES

Membership shall be open to any woman who indicates her desire to belong and to participate in the global mission of the church through UMW.

Circle Organization: We are organized around "circles", or groups of women, who meet together for the purpose of prayer, Bible study, and timely issues and fellowship. To meet the needs of the members and to insure inclusiveness, our Circles gather at different times and on different days. An effort will be made to make morning circles equal in strength. Due to the schedules of their members, afternoon and evening circles are not reorganized. Circle leaders, co-leaders, and program leaders are recommended by the Committee on Nominations, with input from circles, and elected by the unit. Each Circle has the responsibility to host one general meeting per year and should participate fully in all local projects.

Alternative Memberships: Although we are primarily organized around "circles of women", FBSUMW welcomes women who prefer to be members-at-large. Members-at-large will be sent a cover letter, yearbook, pertinent UMW materials, a pledge card, and periodic UMW updates. All ministers are ex-officio members of FBSUMW, and the Senior Pastor is an ex-officio member of the Executive Board. Members-at-large are encouraged to attend General Meetings, to visit various circles, and to involve themselves fully in all the activities, projects, and ministries of the local unit.

General Meetings: The UMW Constitution requires at least four general meetings each year. The dates of the meetings will be determined by the Executive Board and will be published in the yearbook. At least two of the General meetings will be scheduled in the evening in order to accommodate the schedules of working women. Customary times for general meetings are:

1. March luncheon meeting - "A Call to Prayer and Self-Denial"
2. May dinner meeting
3. September dinner meeting - Election of officers
4. November luncheon meeting - "World Thank Offering" - vote on upcoming year's budget
5. December luncheon - installation of officers: distribution of upcoming year's yearbooks

Executive Board: The Executive Board of FBSUMW will meet the second Wednesday of each month, or an alternative time at the discretion of the Executive Board. Every effort will be made to adapt the schedule to meet the needs of all members of the Executive Board.

FINANCES

Budget: The Finance Committee, chaired by the Treasurer will prepare and recommend a budget for approval at the November general meeting. The budget shall include all missions to which the unit wishes to contribute and all expected expenses of the unit.

Special Projects: Additional funds or items are given by members to: Call to Prayer and Self-Denial, World Thank Offering, Blanket Drive, and selected district and conference projects.

Non-budgeted requests: Shall be considered on a case-by-case basis.

Memorials: If a member of the local unit dies, \$15.00 will be sent to the District Treasurer in her memory. If a spouse, parent, or child of our local UMW member dies, \$10.00 is sent to the Library Fund in their memory.

General Meeting Speakers: If a speaker is not a member of our church or associated with UMW, \$25.00 will be donated to the organization of his\her choice. Travel expenses will be determined by the Executive Board.

Solicitation of Funds at General Meetings: No one shall solicit funds at general meetings. Membership shall not be asked to donate to a guest speaker's organization.

Circle Projects: Plans and projects of circles which involve money, but are not included in the budget shall be presented to the Executive Board. Circle leaders should be prepared to share this information at the regular monthly meetings.

NOMINATIONS AND ELECTED LEADERS

Nominating Committee: A committee on nominations shall be composed of members to be elected at the time of the election of officers and others as needed. No member shall serve in this capacity for more than four consecutive years. The chairperson of the committee shall serve in this capacity no more than two consecutive years.

Election of Officers: The nominating committee shall secure a slate of officers for the unit, for vote by the membership at the September general meeting. Elected leaders will be installed at the December general meeting or at another time set by Executive Board.

ELECTED LEADERS AND TERMS OF OFFICE

One Year Term: President-Elect, Historian, Yearbook

Two Year Term: President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer, Secretary of Program Resources, Chair of Committee on Nominations, Communications Coordinator, Committee members on Nominations, Mission Coordinators (Spiritual Growth, Social Action, Mission Education and Interpretation, Membership, Nurture and Outreach). These terms are staggered.

BY-LAWS

Article V, Section 1: Elections-The term of office shall be determined by the local unit.

Article V, Section 2: Tenure of Office - No officer shall hold the same office for more than four (4) consecutive years. Service of six months or more in an officer year by an interim or acting officer will be counted as one year's tenure.

EXECUTIVE BOARD MAKE –UP AND PROCEDURES

Elected officers are members of the UMW Board. This does not include circle co-chairs or program leaders. They are, however, included in the installation of officers at the December meeting. A quorum at Board meetings will be a majority (51%) of those on the Board.

The President shall vote if there is a tie, or if the vote is secret ballot.

Roberts Revised Rules of Order shall prevail at all times unless otherwise stated.

The President shall be made aware of recommendations before they are presented to the Executive Board or to the general meeting. A written copy of the recommendation shall be presented to the Secretary.

The Treasurer shall give a financial report at each board meeting and each general meeting, including receipts from circles and disbursements since the last board meeting. A written report should be presented at least quarterly.

The President, Secretary, and Historian shall be given copies of all reports sent to the district by officers. A copy shall also be kept in the officers' files.

The President shall give copies of all district newsletters to mission coordinators who do not regularly receive them in the mail.

The President shall convey pertinent information from the "Holstonian" to the board and to the general membership.

Past President shall be a member of the Executive Board for 1 year after serving as President.

JOB DESCRIPTION

Any person asked to be an officer shall be given a copy of the “Job Description” pertaining to that office, as well as a copy of the Standing Rules”. This is the responsibility of the Committee on Nominations. “Job Descriptions” are located in the Constitution and By Laws (handbook) and in the Focus on Local and District Units handbook. Additional duties of the elected officials, especially mission coordinators are outlined in the Nominations booklet for the FBSUMC unit. Current copies of these are kept in the UMW Library section. All elected officers are requested to avail themselves of these materials in order to gain a better understanding of their jobs and the interrelationship of all offices.

ADDITIONAL DUTIES OF OFFICERS

Special duties unique to our local unit which are not listed in the Constitution and By-laws will be distributed to nominees and a copy kept in the UMW library. The Standing Rules shall be reviewed each year with changes approved by the Board and voted on by the unit. Rules were reviewed and changes were approved by the board. Unit voted to accept these changes in December, 2016.

UNITED METHODIST WOMEN AND GIVING

For over 140 years United Methodist Women have been changing lives around the world through mission giving. We reach 120 countries, and more than 2 million people in the United States.

Each year we have a local budget that includes the money we plan on spending for the year. Our yearly pledges and projects are what this covers. Most members will want to make a pledge and will support whatever else she can.

Both the Kingsport District and the Holston Conference support a specific project in the fall, usually in the conference.

Each individual circle prepares and serves a meal for Terrific Tuesday at Community UMC and each circle is responsible for a meal once a year at the unit general meeting.

In summary, giving in our unit is as follows:

January: Pledges for the budget

March: Prayer and Self-Denial Offering

May: Church World Service Blanket Drive in unit and in circles; \$5 buys a wool blanket

September: Conference and District projects

November: World Thank offering (collected all year) is turned in. This is an expression of our gratitude for God’s abundance.

We would like to encourage our members to become Five-Star Women by giving a minimum of \$5 for pledge to mission; a minimum of \$40 for a Special Mission recognition to honor someone, a minimum of \$5 for a gift to mission card to honor someone, a minimum of \$5 for a gift in memory of someone, and a minimum of \$5 for the World Thank offering.
